Reservations have been made for the GMD Reviewers. Please present your credit card upon check-in. The rooms will be charged to your credit card and reimbursed to you after the review and when the travel voucher is created and processed for reimbursement.

To reach the hotel from Denver International Airport, take Pena Blvd to the E-470 Tollway North, Exit 6B- toward Fort Collins (approx. 4 miles). Merge onto E-470 North (Portions toll). E 470 North becomes Northwest Parkway West (Portions toll). Northwest Parkway West becomes Storage Tek Drive. (approx 18 miles) Merge onto US-36 West. (approx 9 miles) US-36 West turns into 28th Street and will take you into Boulder. Our hotel is on the left side of 28th Street, just past Colorado Avenue and before Arapahoe Avenue.


Transportation from Millennium to David Skaggs Research Center

Transportation will be provided by a GMD van from the Millennium and back each day. Pick up time is 8:00 AM each morning at the hotel front door.

Driving Directions from DIA

Toll Free:

- Exit Denver International Airport via Peña Boulevard.
- Take Peña Boulevard to I-70 West.
- Split right on I-270 North (Exit 279), toward Ft. Collins and follow across I-25 to US-36 toward Boulder.
- Take US-36 (Boulder Turnpike) West.
- Exit US-36 at Baseline Road (University of Colorado Main Campus exit).
- Keep left and turn left (West) onto Baseline.
- Keep left and turn left at the first light onto 27th Way.
- Stay in the middle lane and turn left onto Broadway.
- Take the second right at the light onto Rayleigh Rd. and bear right into the Visitors Center parking lot.

Toll Road:

• Exit Peña Boulevard at E-470 and follow to US-36. Tolls are \$8.50 each way. Expense will be reimbursed for Reviewers.

By Bus

Regional bus service to Boulder is available through the <u>RTD</u>. The AB bus provides service between Boulder and the Denver International Airport. The B bus provides regional service between Denver and Boulder. Ash Avenue and Broadway is the closest stop to the visitor center

and is served by the Skip, Dash, AB, B, DD, DM, GS, and J bus routes. The Flatiron Park-n-Ride (Broadway and 27th Way) is also close by and is additionally served by the Bound and the 204 routes.

By Airport Shuttle

SuperShuttle, 303-227-0000, provides service from the airport to locations in Boulder.

You will need to make your own reservations with SuperShuttle using your own credit card. This expense will be reimbursed though your travel voucher. When making reservations please specify round trip and that your destination is the Millennium Hotel in Boulder Colorado. Hourly departures from Denver International Airport to Boulder from 7:10am to 11.10pm. Return trips to Denver International Airport depart the hotel hourly between 4:45am and 10:45pm.

The SuperShuttle desk at Denver International Airport is located on Level 5/Baggage Claim, adjacent to the Premier Art Installation in the center of the main terminal. Counter staff will issue tickets and give directions to the van loading areas.

If you would prefer Julie make the reservations for you, she will need your credit card information.

Security Procedure for Visitors

- Visitors are required to sign in and receive a visitor badge from the Visitors Center at the Security Checkpoint.
- Visitors to the site who are U.S. citizens need to present a U.S. photo ID, such as a current state driver's license. Foreign Nationals must present a valid passport or a "green card" (originals only -- no photocopies accepted).
- To receive a visitor badge, all visitors are required to park next to the Security Checkpoint and enter the Visitors Center to be screened before proceeding to their destination.
